



Regional Revival Fund Grant Program

Applications for the scheme will close on 24 June 2016

The Regional Revival Fund Grant Program is open to private sector businesses and local councils (including council-owned businesses) to assist with capital costs associated with new, or upgrading, economic, environmental and social infrastructure projects that will generate or sustain ongoing economic activity and jobs.

The program will see jobs created in regional Tasmania through assisting eligible proponents to bring forward projects that would otherwise be delayed or not proceed allowing them to generate or sustain ongoing economic activity and jobs.

Approximately \$2.2 million is available to support additional projects through this Expression of Interest process and it is generally expected that grants would be for no more than one-half of the total capital expenditure of an applicant's project.

One-off grants of between \$100,000 and \$2 million per project are on offer to eligible applicants.
