As a long-time supporter of the Chudleigh Agricultural and Pastoral Show, I was pleased to provide this important community event with a \$15,000 grant for essential infrastructure and maintenance.

First celebrated in 1889, the Chudleigh show is one of Tasmania's oldest agricultural shows. Today the event showcases and promotes the local agricultural industries, as well as fine local produce and entertainment.

A great day out for the family, patrons can expect to see poultry, cattle, sheep, horses, dairy heifers and sheep dogs as they show and compete for "best of show".

Popular features include; ute displays, vintage tractors, horse activities, wood chopping and the perennial favourite, the annual running of the Chudleigh Cup.

As usual the lack of horses competing in the Cup will be more than made up for by enthusiastic entrants dressed up as horses.

There will also be free Kid's activities run all day from 10am in a dedicated area.
