Go Evandale Weagles!

As a long-time supporter of the Evandale football and cricket clubs, I was pleased to join my friend and colleague Mark Shelton to watch the Weagles team win recently.

We also had the opportunity to inspect the recently installed hybrid cricket wicket and view the scores via the new electronic scoreboard, both made possible thanks to two grants totalling \$63,000 grants from the Hodgman Liberal Government.
