

BARNETT VOWS TO BE PRO-DEVELOPMENT AND PRO-JOBS

Only the Liberal Party can deliver the stable, majority Government Tasmania so desperately needs, State Liberal Lyons candidate Guy Barnett will tell over 100 guests who will attend his official campaign launch at Longford tonight.

State Liberal Leader Will Hodgman will officially launch Mr Barnett's campaign with the former Senator confident the party can win three seats in the electorate at next March's election.

"The success of Eric Hutchinson in winning the Federal seat last month with a swing of more than 11 per cent electorate-wide is a clear sign that the people of Lyons are fed up with the Labor Government hamstrung by the Greens," Mr Barnett said.

"They saw the damage done nationally and are living through the damage being done at a State level."
