Labor feigns support for forestry

The Tasmanian Liberal Government is the strongest supporter of our renewable, sustainable forestry industry, which contributes around \$1.2 billion to the Tasmanian economy and provides thousands of direct and indirect jobs, many in regional communities.

Tasmania's forestry sector will never forget the thousands of jobs lost because Labor and the Greens locked up our productive forests through their disastrous Tasmanian Forests Agreement.
