Championing healthcare in our communities

The Rockliff Liberal Government is tirelessly working to ensure that the East Devonport community has access to the service that it needs following the Medical Centre's merger with SmartClinics Devonport.

Minister for Health, Guy Barnett, said that Tasmanians deserve access to healthcare that meets their needs and expectations and that the Federal Government's failure to adequately invest in Medicare is putting GP clinics at risk.
